## Contractor Environment, Safety & Health (ESH) Site Briefing – Denver, Colorado

Waterton - Coherent

The purpose of the Contractor ESH briefing is for LMSSC to provide information to all contractors (non-LM employees) with key ESH items and protocols to safeguard contractors, visitors, LM employees and environment while working at LMSSC

#### **General Policies**

- Use of LMSSC owned/leased equipment (e.g. portable ladders, cranes, forklifts, tools, Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), vehicles, etc.) is prohibited, unless the Contractor obtains written permission from LM
- Follow good housekeeping practices
- Designate work areas with safety barriers and signage as needed
- Obey all traffic rules and speed limits, park in designated areas
- Give pedestrians & bicyclists right of way
- Only hands free communication devices shall be used; No texting & driving

### **Emergencies**

- Dial **911** from an in-house phone to report emergencies
- From outside line (e.g. mobile phone) at the Waterton Facility dial (303) 977-4646
- At the Coherent Facility dial **911** from an in house or mobile phone
- Report all emergencies, incidents, and accidents immediately to the contractor supervisor and LM Point of Contact
- Provide the dispatcher with the following information:
  - Type of emergency (hazardous material spill, medical, fire)
  - Location (e.g. street, building no., floor, column no., etc)
- For Environment, Safety and Health dial (303) 977-4444
- Evacuate the building using the nearest exit
- Reenter only when given the all clear by LM

#### **Potential Site Hazards**

Potential hazards you may encounter at LMSSC:

- Hazardous materials / hazardous waste
- Ionizing radiation / non-ionizing radiation (lasers)
- Ordnance / Explosives Briefing may be required
- Cryogenics
- Oxygen Deficient Atmospheres
- Confined Spaces
- Asbestos & Lead
- Rattle snakes

#### **Contractor Hazardous Activities**

Contractors shall coordinate with their LM POC and ESH when conducting activates that involve:

- Chemical use / Hazardous Material / Hazardous Waste
- Lock Out / Tag Out
- Demolition
- Ordnance
- Asbestos / Lead / Cadmium Sampling and Abatement
- Confined Spaces
- Hot Work
- Excavation / Trenching
- Working at Heights (e.g. roofs)
- Live Electrical Work
- Lifts / Cranes
