Recent Milestones

- First F-16 Block 70, for Bahrain, completes first flight in Greenville, South Carolina. The flight occurred Jan. 24 at 9:17 a.m. ET, with Lockheed Martin test pilots Dwayne "Pro" Opella and Monessa "Siren" Balzhiser. (January 2023)
- Lockheed Martin, Hellenic Aerospace Industry, and the Hellenic Air Force (HAF) held a ceremony to mark the inauguration of several industrial projects at HAI -- and to celebrate the delivery of the fifth HAF jet to be upgraded to the F-16 "Viper" configuration. (January 2023)
- On Jan. 19, Jordan signed an additional Letter of Offer and Acceptance (LOA) for four more jets. (Jan 2023).
