An F-16 Block 70 takes off in full afterburner from Lockheed Martin's Greenville, South Carolina, facility to join the tranche of more than 700 F-16s serving with European air forces. The F-16 remains central to NATO air policing and frontline deterrence alongside allied fleets.

Recent Milestones

- On Oct. 2, two new F-16 Block 70 jets arrived in Slovakia, strengthening the nation's air force with advanced radar, avionics and mission systems that enhance security and ensure seamless NATO interoperability.
- Lockheed Martin and Hellenic Aerospace Industry on Sept. 23 delivered the 42nd upgraded F-16V to the Hellenic Air Force, marking the halfway point in Greece's fleet modernization program.
- Sept. 16 saw an advance in pilot training as Lockheed Martin announced plans to modernize nine Republic of Korea Air Force F-16 simulators to the Viper configuration, providing training systems aligned with the aircraft's latest capabilities.
- The U.S. State Department on Sept. 15 approved a possible sale of 12 F-16 Block 70 aircraft and support to Peru, a step that reinforces national security and advances long-term partnership with the United States.
