Recent Milestones

- On Nov. 3, the governments of the Netherlands and Romania signed an agreement transferring ownership of 18 Dutch F-16s to Romanian authorities, underscoring Romania's growing leadership in allied training and cooperation through the European F-16 Training Center.
- On Oct. 20, Romania's 48th Fighter Squadron at the 71st "General Emanoil Ionescu" Air Base began NATO-led air policing, marking the certification of the country's second F-16 squadron and strengthening the Alliance's eastern flank and integrated air defense posture.
- On Oct. 17, a South Dakota Air National Guard F-16 passed 10,000 flight hours, a milestone that reflects the platform's enduring reliability and long service life across the global fleet.
- In October, four new F-16 Block 70 jets arrived in Europe two for Slovakia and two for Bulgaria – boosting national readiness with APG-83 AESA radar, upgraded avionics and mission systems built for NATO interoperability.
