Recent Milestones

- On April 20, Peru's government signed a contract for the F-16 Block 70, marking a major step in the Peruvian Air Force's fighter fleet transformation, reinforcing a longstanding strategic partnership with the United States and enabling industrial-collaboration opportunities.
- On April 15, the Hellenic Air Force received its 50th F-16V fighter aircraft, delivered by Lockheed Martin in partnership with Hellenic Aerospace Industry (HAI), as Greece continues to move forward with one of Europe's most active fighter modernization efforts.
- The Romanian Air Force assumed NATO's Baltic Air Policing mission in Šiauliai, Lithuania, on April 1, marking its fourth deployment from the country and reinforcing its sustained commitment to allied collective defense.
