Recent Milestones

- Argentina's Ministry of Defence hosted a ceremony on Feb. 24 to celebrate the arrival of the country's first F-16s. These Fighting Falcons will enhance capabilities of the Argentine Air Force (Fuerza Aérea Argentina - FAA) and strengthen interoperability between America and Argentina.
- On Jan. 31, Lockheed Martin celebrated the delivery of the first F-16 Block 70 jet to Bulgaria, marking a major milestone in the country's air force modernization efforts, with Bulgaria's Minister of Defence, Atanas Zapryanov, and American leaders attending a ceremony in Greenville, South Carolina.
- L3Harris Technologies announced on Feb. 4 the first flight of the Viper Shield electronic warfare system was completed in a single-seat F-16 Block 70, operated by the 416th Flight Test Squadron at Edwards Air Force Base, California.
