The first F-16 Block 70 has rolled out to the flight line at the production facility in Greenville, South Carolina, in preparation of first flight.

Recent Milestones -

- Bulgaria signs Letter of Offer and Acceptance to purchase eight additional F-16 Block 70 jets. (November 2022)
- First F-16 Block 70, for Bahrain, completes Final Assembly and Checkout (FACO) process in Greenville, SC and moves to paint. (October 2022)
- Lockheed Martin and Hellenic Aerospace Industry jointly deliver the first two upgraded F-16V fighters to the Hellenic Air Force. (September 2022)
- Lockheed Martin mates wing on first South Carolina-built F-16. (August 2022)
