## Recent Milestones

- The first European F-16 Training Center was inaugurated on Nov. 13, at the Fetești Air Base in southern Romania. (November 2023)
- The Slovak Republic's first F-16 Block 70 jet successfully completed its inaugural flight on Sept. 29 at 9:30 a.m. EST at Lockheed Martin's production facility in Greenville, South Carolina. (September 2023)
- The Ministry of National Defence of Romania, the Minister of Defence of the Kingdom of the Netherlands and Lockheed Martin signed a Letter of Intent to establish the European F-16 Training Center in Romania. (August 2023)
- PZL Mielec, a Lockheed Martin company and one of Poland's longest-established aircraft manufacturers, celebrated completion of the first F-16 Block 70/72 aft fuselage manufactured in Poland. (August 2023)
