Mr. Martig:

As part of the on-going cleanup activities for the Airdock, Lockheed Martin has placed contracts with qualified firms for demolition of the existing vertical siding below the gutter line of the Airdock and installation of new siding as described in the June 8, 2005 plan previously submitted to you. This work includes provisions for the installation and maintenance of air barriers to fully encapsulate the construction area. This will protect the construction area from wind and weather on the exterior of the Airdock and prevent any debris created during the demolition or installation from entering the Airdock. The scope of work for these contracts is described in Section 4 of each bid specification which is attached. Mobilization of the contractors for this project will begin this week; however, actual removal of siding will not start for at least two weeks.

Section 55 of the Consent Agreement and Final Order (CAFO) requires Lockheed Martin to provide five working days advanced notice of any activity that could potentially create turbulence or disturbance of dust within the Airdock. This letter is the notification to you of this project.
