Attached is the Remedial Action Construction and Completion Report ("RACCR") for the Lockheed West Seattle Superfund Site, Seattle, Washington, dated September 30, 2020. Your signature will document formal EPA acceptance of the RACCR and completion of the Remedial Action. I have reviewed the RACCR and find it consistent with OSWER Directive 9320.2-22 Close Out Procedures for National Priority List Sites and recommend EPA acceptance.

The Lockheed West Seattle cleanup was designed by the Lockheed Martin Corporation and was conducted with EPA oversight. Remedial action was substantively completed in March 2020, with ongoing work on institutional controls (environmental covenant).

The remaining activities on this site are identified in the EPA approved Remedial Action Work Plans – the Long-term Maintenance, and Monitoring Plan and Institutional Control Implementation and Assurance Plan (Lockheed, 2018). UECA covenants are required for owned and/or managed property parcels by the Port of Seattle and the Washington Department of Natural Resources. Five-year reviews are required for the site starting in August 2023.
