

SECTION F.6 STATEMENT APPLICANT'S COMPLIANCE HISTORY

Lockheed Martin Corporation (LMC) is to become the Potentially Responsible Party at this site (RTN 3-518). Current permits at this site include a Hazardous Waste Small Quantity Generator Facility ID number of MAD985290873.

In addition, LMC is the Potentially Responsible Party for two additional Massachusetts Contingency Plan (MCP) sites. These are listed below:

- Former RCA Facility, 1 Network Drive, Burlington, MA, RTN 3-265 – This is a Tier IB site that is currently in Remedy Operation Status (ROS) with monitored natural attenuation as the remedy. The most recent status report was submitted in June 2011. This report states that annual groundwater and surface monitoring continues at the site with the next monitoring to occur in November 2011. This site is in current compliance with the MCP.
- Former GE Facility, 50 Fordham Road, Wilmington, MA, RTN 3-28282 – This is a Tier IC site located at the same address as RTN 3-518. RTN 3-28282, however, is not related to the former GE facility operations, but is related to elevated levels of arsenic in the site groundwater. A Phase I and Tier Classification was submitted in January 2010. A Phase II Comprehensive Site Assessment and Phase III Remedial Action Plan are due on January 8, 2012. This site is in current compliance with the MCP.

LMC has not been a subject of Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) actions such as Notices of Noncompliance, Administrative Enforcement Orders, Notices of Intent to Assess Civil Administrative Penalties, Judicial Consent Judgments, or similar actions taken by other state, federal, or local agencies and/or criminal or civil actions material to this disposal site brought on behalf of MassDEP, or other federal, state, or local agencies.
