SUBJECT: Updated U.S. Facility Masking Requirements

Consistent with the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidance and Lockheed Martin policy, the following masking requirements are effective immediately.

Fully vaccinated Lockheed Martin visitors and on-site personnel who **certify** their vaccination status through [VisitLM](#) will no longer be required to wear a mask or physically distance at U.S. locations where business is conducted (e.g. Lockheed Martin, customer and supplier facilities), **unless**:

- In an indoor setting in counties of [substantial or high transmission](#) (as defined by the CDC);
- Where required by federal, state, local, Business Area*, or site-specific rules and regulations; or
- After a known exposure to someone with suspected or confirmed COVID-19, in which case the exposed individual must mask for 14-days or until receiving a negative test result (tested 3-5 days after exposure).

*Note: Masks are required indoors at all U.S. Aeronautics sites, regardless of vaccination status.

Individuals are considered "fully vaccinated" for COVID-19 greater than two weeks after they have received the second dose in a two-dose series, or greater than two weeks after they have received a single-dose vaccine and have certified in VisitLM.
