As mentioned on both Rise Up webinars with the Navy and Army, the implementation of CMMC is a focus area. FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTION

What is the Cybersecurity Maturity Model Certification (CMMC)?

Fundamentally, the [U.S. Department of Defense Cybersecurity Maturity Model Certification \(CMMC\)](#) is an assessment model that rates a company's cybersecurity maturity. The model, led by the Office of Under Secretary of Defense (OUSD) for Acquisition and Sustainment, is intended to have an accredited third-party assess all companies doing business with DoD and place them in a maturity level. Further, DoD contract data will be categorized for criticality and a commensurate maturity level will be assigned.

As we anticipate seeing CMMC in RFIs in 3Q 2020 and on contracts as early as October, getting a head start is the best strategy for minimizing potential supply chain disruptions. The [CyberAssist - CMMC Site](#) has been established by Defense Industry Primes to provide vetted resources and support to small businesses supporting US DoD. Lockheed Martin depends on a shared commitment with our suppliers to protect the sensitive information that supports delivering on critical customer missions.
