

CCTT Concurrency Mandatory Flow-Down Provisions

The Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) clauses and Defense Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement (DFARS) referenced below are incorporated herein by reference, with the same force and effect as if they were given in full text, and are applicable, including any notes following the clause citation, to this Contract. If the date or substance of any of the clauses listed below is different from the date or substance of the clause actually incorporated in the Prime Contract referenced by number herein, the date or substance of the clause incorporated by said Prime Contract shall apply instead. The Contracts Disputes Act shall have no application to this Contract. Any reference to a "Disputes" clause shall mean the "Disputes" clause of this Contract.

The provisions of Section II – FAR FLOWDOWN PROVISIONS of the Subcontracts/Purchase Order terms and conditions apply to these clauses.

Additional Clauses – Full Text

5152.227-5002 NOTICE REGARDING THE DISSEMINATION OF EXPORT-CONTROLLED TECHNICAL DATA (PEO-STRI) (SEP 2006)

- (a) Export of information contained herein, which includes release to foreign nationals within the United States, without first obtaining approval or license from the Department of State for items controlled by the International Traffic in Arms Regulations (ITARs), or the Department of Commerce for items controlled by the Export Administration Regulations (EAR), may constitute a violation of law.
- (b) For violation of export laws, the contractor, its employees, officials or agents are subject to:
 - (1) Imprisonment and/or imposition of criminal fines; and
 - (2) Suspension or debarment from future Government contracting actions.
- (c) The Government shall not be liable for any unauthorized use or release of export-controlled information, technical data or specifications in this contract.
- (d) The contractor shall include the provisions or paragraphs (a) through (c) above in any subcontracts awarded under this contract.

GOVERNMENT RIGHTS IN GOVERNMENT FURNISHED INFORMATION (GFI) *(applies only if GFI is provided)*

The Government is providing Lockheed Martin Government Furnished Information that includes, but is not limited to, the Technical Data Package (TDP), CCTT software, drawings, and documentation. The GFI is being provided to Lockheed Martin with Unlimited rights, and any modifications to the GFI shall be provided back to the Government with no less than Unlimited rights.
