PACKAGING OF INBOUND HAZARDOUS SHIPMENTS

1.0 SCOPE

- 1.1 This standard provides for the packaging, marking, and labeling of inbound shipments of material for which its manufacturer maintains and supplies a Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS).
- 1.2 All specified documents shall be to "latest revision".

2.0 GENERAL

- 2.1 The requirements of LPS 40–001 (General Requirements Specification) shall be met in addition to the provisions of this packaging standard.
- 2.2 Regulated hazardous shipments are to be packaged, marked, and labeled per the Department of Transportation Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations (49 CFR), International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO), or International Air Transport Association (IATA).
- 2.3 Non regulated hazardous shipments shall be packaged, marked and labeled to LPS 40-001.

3.0 UNIT PACKAGING

3.1 The quantity per unit package shall be as specified in the procurement document, or if unspecified, quantity shall be as commonly furnished by the supplier providing applicable regulations are met.
