Diversity of product lines makes accurately accounting for each product/product line cost ineffective	We do not have an activity-based accounting system for infrastructure costs which would permit us to more accurately track and allocate emissions for each of our product and service offerings. Furthermore, our complex supply chain with many layers presents even more of a challenge because a large proportion of GHG emissions can be attributed to the supply chain.
Doing so would require we disclose business sensitive/proprietary information	In order to overcome emissions allocation challenges, we are more open to working closely with our customers to obtain a better understanding of contract value and emissions associated with that work. Due to the sensitive and classified nature of some of our work for federal government customers, we may not be able to fully disclose information that could contribute to a better emissions allocation estimate.
