

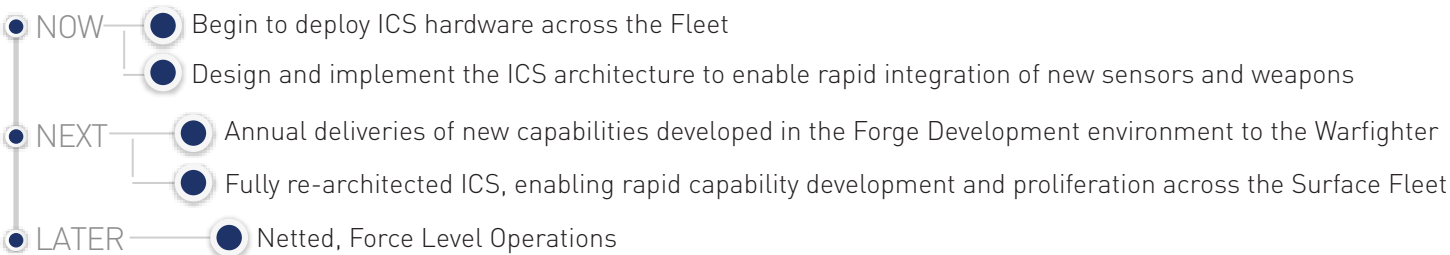
Integrated Combat System
